#### Welcome Delegates,

We are pleased to welcome everyone to the 23rd Women's Cancer Initiative meeting on Breast Cancer to be held between 10th and 12th October in Mumbai. The management of breast cancer continues to evolve rapidly as we strive to balance between underdiagnosis for the majority and overtreatment for a few, and treatment-related toxicity, quality of life, and improved outcomes. Overall, the multidisciplinary treatment of breast cancers has substantially improved over the last 50 years, with more systemic therapy options, better radiation techniques, and attention to cosmesis and morbidity in breast cancer surgery. We routinely follow evidence from the West since the majority of the systemic therapy trials have been and are being reported from there. However, there is a distinct difference in the demographic presentation of disease in the West and LMICs like ours. We continue to have a higher percentage of locally advanced disease at presentation and non-screened, symptomatic early breast cancers. This is accompanied by a steadily rising incidence of breast cancer in India. With increasing awareness and the wide availability of screening strategies, there will hopefully be a stage migration in India. Hence, several de-escalation strategies need to be applied in the right context in our setting. Also, evidence for the management of certain advanced-stage diseases is lacking from the West. Hence, Indian guidelines are needed. This year, the theme is "From controversies to consensus" in these grey zone areas in the management of breast cancer that are more pertinent to our country, through focused discussions, debates, case-based learning, and panel discussions. A group of eminent oncologists from all over the country will participate in the truly multidisciplinary brainstorming sessions, and there will be an open consensus guideline development at the end of every session. emerging with a manuscript at the end for more India-specific questions.

We hope you will take the opportunity to join us in this sincere academic endeavor and after-hours revelry and will enjoy the program as much as we enjoy making it.

Dr. Carlotta Becherini is a radiation oncologist based in Florence, Italy, where she practices at the Radiation Oncology Unit of Azienda Ospedaliero-Universitaria Careggi and collaborates with the Department of Experimental and Clinical Biomedical Sciences at the University of Florence. She is actively involved in clinical care using advanced radiation techniques such as IMRT, VMAT, SBRT, adaptive radiotherapy, and brachytherapy, with a particular focus on breast cancer, head and neck tumors, and stereotactic treatments. Dr. Becherini holds a Master's Degree in Drug and Radiotherapy Combinations, a qualification that supports her specialized interest in integrating systemic therapies with radiotherapy in both clinical and research settings. She is part of the ESTRO Focus Group on Systemic Therapy and Radiotherapy Combinations, where she contributes to shaping international standards for the safe and effective use of combined modalities in cancer treatment. Nationally, she serves on the Scientific Committee for the Italian Breast Cancer Guidelines, helping define evidence-based protocols and treatment pathways. Her scientific work includes co-authorship of several high-impact publications and consensus documents, including an ESTRO-endorsed international consensus on integrating systemic therapies with radiation in breast cancer, a Delphi-based national consensus on breast reconstruction and radiotherapy timing, and expert contributions on moderate and ultra-hypofractionation approaches. She is particularly engaged in advancing partial breast irradiation techniques, both in clinical application and in research efforts aimed at refining patient selection and optimizing treatment planning. Dr. Becherini takes part in international congresses and expert panels dedicated to breast cancer care, contributing her clinical experience and research expertise to the ongoing development of multidisciplinary treatment strategies.

**Dr. Nisha Sharma** is Director for Breast Screening at Leeds & Wakefield the 14th Largest breast screening unit and Consultant breast radiologist at Leeds Teaching Hospital NHS Trust, Chair of the Research and Innovation Development Access Committee (RIDAC) for national breast screening programme & Clinical advisor to NHS England related to breast screening issues and Professional Clinical Advisor for breast quality assurance visits. She is passionate about using innovation to improve the patient pathway.

She developed the national guidelines on how to manage high risk lesions diagnosed within breast screening with vacuum assisted excision rather than surgery, which has been adopted at a national level and was also involved in writing the EUSOMA guidelines on how to manage high risk lesions in Europe. This change in pathway has meant many women can avoid a surgical operation.

She is active in research and audit. She has over 100 peer reviewed publications. She is the radiology lead for the SMALL trial and Tadpole trial. These trials focus on minimising overtreatment. She is working with artificial intelligence looking at AI assessment of quality of mammograms, diagnostic role in 2D and 3D mammograms and in ultrasound. She also has an interest in breast density.

She conducted the first prospective trial in breast screening looking at the impact of AI on arbitration rates.

She is the audit lead for the British Society of Breast Radiology, scientific committee member for EUSOBI and scores abstracts for RSNA, ARRS, ECR, Eusobi and BSBR. She is an invited national and international speaker, covering many topics such as high risk lesions, CEM, DBT, breast MRI, AI and the axilla.
