Dr. Saketh Guntupalli

Gynecologic Oncology UCHealth Cancer Care -Anschutz Medical Campus - University of Colorado Cancer Center

Saketh R. Guntupalli, MD is an Associate Professor, Karen M. Jennison Endowed Chair in Gynecologic Oncology, and Director of the Division of Gynecologic Oncology at the University of Colorado School of Medicine at Denver. He formerly served as Vice-Chair for Clinical Affairs Quality in the Department of OB-GYN and director of the fellowship program in gynecologic oncology He received his undergraduate degree from Johns Hopkins University and his medical degree from the University of Texas at Houston. After a 4-year residency in obstetrics and gynecology at Baylor College of Medicine, Dr. Guntupalli completed an additional 3-year surgical fellowship in gynecologic oncology and advanced pelvic surgery at Washington University in St. Louis. Dr. Guntupalli is a leading national and international expert in women's cancer and has lectured all over the world on surgical expertise and molecular mechanisms of cancer. He has authored over 60 clinical papers and has led multiple collaborative research studies focused on improving post-operative surgical outcomes as well as identifying novel therapies for the treatment of ovarian and uterine cancer. With over \$3,000,000 in independent research funding, Dr. Guntupalli has led the NRG collaborative research consortium at the University of Colorado Cancer Center for nearly 4 years. Dr. Guntupalli has additional expertise in sexual dysfunction broadly in cancer patients and has authored a New York Times review of the book and multiple editorials in Forbes. He serves on multiple national committees including the Chair of Legislative Affairs for the Society of Gynecologic Oncology and as well as serving on the executive committee of the Western Association of Gynecologic Oncologists. He is a member of the editorial board of Obstetrics and Gynecology

Dr. Akila Viswanathan

Director, Johns Hopkins Radiation Oncology and Molecular Radiation Sciences Professor of Radiation Oncology and Molecular Radiation Sciences

Akila Viswanathan, M.D., M.P.H., is the director for Johns Hopkins Radiation Oncology and Molecular Radiation Sciences, and a professor of radiation oncology, gynecology/obstetrics and oncology for Johns Hopkins University School of Medicine. Dr. Viswanathan leads the department emphasizing excellence in clinical care, research and She has expertise with gynecologic cancers and their education. treatment, including cervical and uterine cancers and image-guided brachytherapy. She has developed numerous clinical innovations and initiated several system-wide integration efforts at all sites, including Green Spring Station, Bayview, Johns Hopkins Hospital, Suburban's Rockledge site, and Sibley Memorial Hospital for the Johns Hopkins Department of Radiation Oncology. Dr. Viswanathan earned her undergraduate degree at Harvard-Radcliffe College, her medical degree at the University of Pittsburgh School of Medicine, followed by her Masters in Public Health and Masters in Epidemiology at the Harvard School of Public Health. She completed a residency in radiation oncology at the Joint Center for Radiation Therapy at Harvard Medical School, where she served as chief resident. She has had research grant funding through the National Cancer Institute K07, R21 and R01 programs to support efforts in gynecologic cancers, specifically looking at the identification of gynecologic tumors at the time of brachytherapy under magnetic resonance imaging. The research team has developed several novel clinical innovations.

Postdoctoral fellowship in Research Pathology at New England Medical Center -Tufts University, Boston, USA (1991-92) with a part time activity at Massachusetts General Hospital, Harvard University with Dr. Scully. A faculty member of the Pathology Department Hospital de Sant Pau, Barcelona (1988-2002) with Dr Jaime Prat. Author of over 400 publications and member of several editorial boards (Virchow Archiv. Isabelle Ray-Coquard

President of the GINECO group, Professor of medical oncology in University Claude Bernard Lyon I Medical oncologist in the Comprehensive Cancer Center: Centre Leon Bérard (CLB) Lyon France

Prof. Ray-Coquard obtained her medical degree in 1997 specializing in oncology. In 2003 she received her PhD from the Université Claude Bernard for her research on the independents predictive factors determining medical practices in oncology. She also received Master's degrees in in statistics in 1995 and in medical economy in 1996. From 2008 to 2013, she has served as Chairman of the gynaecologic group for clinical trials of the French National Cancer Institute (INCA) and she is currently the Network Director of the national network dedicated to diagnosis and management of the rare gynecological cancer (www.ovaire-rare.org), a network funded by the INCA commission. At the Groupe d'investigateurs national evaluation des cancers de l'ovaire (GINECO), she has been active in the translational research advisory committee, the scientific committee, and as a chairman of endometrial cancer subgroup and the rare tumors committee until 2018. Since 2002, she is also developing translational research dedicated to ovarian cancer with the INSERM/CNRS within the CRCL directed by P Mehlen within the CLB campus, and more directly with the research on rare gyn cancer biology (Carcinosarcoma, Granulosa cell tumors, HGSC, Cervix cancer). From 2009 to 2018, she was the chairman of the rare cancer working group from GCIG (gynaecological cancer intergroup) dedicated to clinical trials in the field of all rare gynaecological cancers. She is the current President of the GINECO group. She is an active member of a number of professional groups, including the American Society of Clinical Oncology, the Connective Tissue Oncology Society, the French Society of Cancer, the European Association of Cancer Research, the EORTC organisation and the European Society of Medical Oncology (ESMO) and the European Society of Gynaecological Oncology (ESGO).

Tatsuya Ohno

Professor and Chair, Dept. of Radiation Oncology, Gunma University Director, Gunma University Heavy Ion Medical Center

Dr. Ohno is a radiation oncologist, Professor and Chair of Department of Radiation Oncology, and Medical Director of Gunma University Heavy Ion Medical Center, Japan. His research has focused on gynecologic cancer treatment and carbon ion therapy for various cancer sites. He is now a core member of the Japan Carbon-ion Radiation Oncology Study Group (J-CROS) since 2014. He was also an External Advisory Board member of Shanghai Proton and Heavy Ion Treatment Center and the Korea Heavy-ion Medical Accelerator (KHIMA) Project in Korea. Dr. Ohno has served as Course Director on International Training Course on Carbon-ion Radiotherapy hosted by NIRS and Gunma University since 2012. He has served a chair of gynecologic tumor committee of the Japan Radiation Oncology Study Group (JROSG) since 2017. He is also a member of Radiation Oncology Project of the Forum for Nuclear Cooperation in Asia (FNCA) for 15 years. In this project, multi-center clinical trials on cervical cancer, nasopharyngeal cancer, and breast cancer have been performed among 11 Asian countries: Bangladesh, China, Indonesia, Japan, Korea, Kazakhstan, Malaysia, Thailand, The Philippines, Mongolia, and Viet Nam.
