Dr. Xavier Matias-Guiu, M.D., Ph.D (XMG) is Professor of Pathology at the University of Barcelona (2019-) and Lleida (2002-). He is also chairman of Pathology Hospital Universitari de Bellvitge, Barcelona (2015-), and Hospital Universitari Arnau de Vilanova de Lleida (2002-). MD from University of Barcelona, 1981, PhD from Autonomous University of Barcelona, 1987. Training in Pathology in Hospital de Sant Pau, Barcelona, Spain, (1983-86). Postdoctoral fellowship in Research Pathology at New England Medical Center-Tufts University, Boston, USA (1991-92). Faculty member of the Pathology Department Hospital de Sant Pau, Barcelona (1988-2002). XMG's research is focused on clinicopathologic features and molecular genetics of gynecological malignancies, with more than 400 publications, and H-index of 63.

XMG was President, Sociedad Española de Anatomía Patológica (2019-21); Member of the Council (2015-19) and chairman of the Education Subcommittee (2021-) of the European Society of Pathology. Member of the Executive committee (2009-2013), and President (2021- 23) of the International Society of Gynecologic Pathologists. Member, the World Health Organization (WHO) panel for Classification of Tumours of the Female Genital Tract, (IARC, Lyon France; 2014 and 2020). He has participated in several different international guidelines in Endometrial Cancer, such as ESMO-ESGO-ESTRO Consensus Conference in 2016, the ISGYP guidelines in 2019, and has been recently chairman for pathology in the ESGO/ESTRO/ESP guidelines for the management of patients with endometrial carcinoma, and in the Dataset for the reporting of endometrial cancer, of the International Collaboration on Cancer Reporting (ICCR) in 2022. He is member also of the FIGO Endometrial Cancer Staging Subcommittee.

Professor Lorusso has been involved in gynecological oncology research for more than 25 years and has conducted or participated in approximately 250 phase I-IV clinical trials in gynecological malignancies. At present she is the Principal Investigator of more than 60 studies. Professor Lorusso is responsible for the Clinical Trials Committee of the MITO (Multicenter Italian Trials in Ovarian Cancer and Gynaecological Malignancies) Group, which includes more than 150 Italian centers involved in gynecological oncology research. She is the member of Board of Directors of Gynecological Cancer Intergroup including 23 international research groups involved into the promotion and conduction of high-quality clinical trials to improve outcomes for women with gynecological cancers. Professor Lorusso is also an active member of ENGOT (European Network of Gynaecological Oncological Trial groups), an international organization that coordinates and promotes clinical trials within Europe for patients with gynecological cancers where she chairs the Gynecological cancer Academy. She is member of Board of Director of European Society of Gynecology Oncology (ESGO). She has also co-authored about 300 international oncology publications. She is author of national and international guidelines on treatment of ovarian, cervical and endometrial cancer. Dr Lorusso's key goals are to ensure best treatment to all patients and promote the clinical research, international trial collaborations and educations.

Dr. Gabriella Macchia is a professor of Radiation Oncology at the Catholic University of Rome, Potenza and Campobasso and, since 2019, she is also the Responsible Research Hospital's deputy Scientific Director. She treats cancer patients, particularly those with gastrointestinal, breast, and gynecological tumours. For almost 25 years, Dr. Macchia has worked in the fields of gynecological oncology and radiotherapy. Currently, she serves as the national point of contact for the Italian Radiation Oncology groups for both the Italian Association of Radiotherapy and Clinical Oncology (AIRO) Gynaecology Study Group and the Multicenter Italian Trials in Ovarian cancer and gynaecologic malignancies (MITO) group. Over the course of her career in oncology, Dr. Macchia co-authored over 300 papers, about 90 of which were on gynaecological themes. Scopus reports that she has an H-index of 33. She participated in the radiotherapy section of the evaluation of national gynaecology guidelines, and she was recently appointed as a radiation oncologist for the study of the new ESGO-ESTRO-ESP endometrial cancer guidelines.

She handled both scientific production and clinical initiatives for radiation oncologist groups, providing strategic guidance. Dr. Macchia, a firm believer in the power of technology to accelerate progress in healthcare, recently led Italian Radiation Oncology groups in harnessing data science and intelligent automation for insight generation, so that teams work as a united front, with expertise and purpose, to solve the world's most difficult health challenges.

Her research programme focusses on improving cancer diagnostics, cancer surgery and addressing inequalities in cancer outcomes. Dr. Sudha's research has led to change of NICE guidelines to recommend maximum cytoreduction surgery for ovarian cancer. She has recently completed her term as the President of the British Gynaecological Cancer Society (2019-2022), the first women gynecological oncologist to be elected to this post.

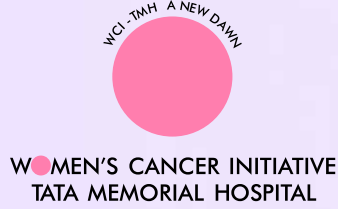

Dr. Basu did his MD in Obstetrics and Gynecology, post-doctoral fellowship in Gynecological Oncology and PhD in Clinical Oncology. He has been awarded the honorary FRCOG by the Royal College of Ob & Gyn, UK recently. Before joining IARC in 2015, he was head of the Department of Gynecological Oncology at the National Cancer Institute in India. Dr. Basu is well known for his research that has informed several guidelines and recommendations from the WHO. His research has been instrumental to recent events that will promote equity in preventing cervical cancer, such as WHO concluding that a single dose of HPV vaccine delivers solid protection, authorities recommending marketing authorization for a new low-cost HPV vaccine in India and WHO recommending a simple and affordable technology (thermal ablation) for treatment of cervical precancers. Evidence generated from his study on the long-term impact of triennial screening for breast cancer with clinical breast examination (CBE) will be very valuable for the WHO's global breast cancer initiative. Dr. Basu has been supporting countries across the globe to implement cancer screening programmes with equity and quality through the project named Cancer Screening in Five Continents (CanScreen5). He is leading implementation research projects aiming at improving cancer early detection in socio-economically disadvantaged populations in three countries in Europe and in India. He has significantly contributed to build capacity in delivering quality assured cervical and breast cancer early detection services in several low and middle income countries.

He completed a fellowship in Radiation Oncology at the Princess Margaret Hospital in Toronto, Ontario, Canada, and completed a residency in Radiation Oncology at the University of Wisconsin Hospital and Clinics in Madison, Wisconsin. Dr. Mohindra also earned a Master of Medical Management for Physicians degree from Carnegie Mellon University in Pittsburgh, Pennsylvania. Following completion of his medical education and training, Dr. Mohindra spent several years practicing in the University of Maryland's Department of Radiation Oncology and teaching at the University of Maryland School of Medicine. Dr. Mohindra also serves as Medical Student Clerkship Director and Course Director for Mock Orals in Radiation Oncology at the University of Maryland. He is also actively involved in the American Society for Radiation Oncology, the Alliance for Clinical Trials in Oncology, the American College of Radiology, the American Brachytherapy Society, and the International Association for the Study of Lung Cancer.

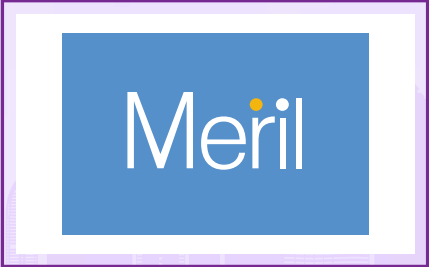
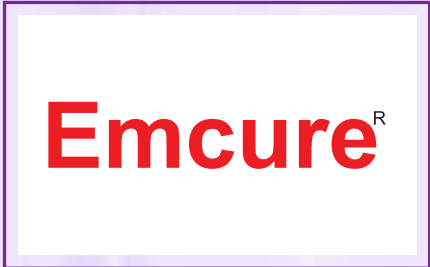
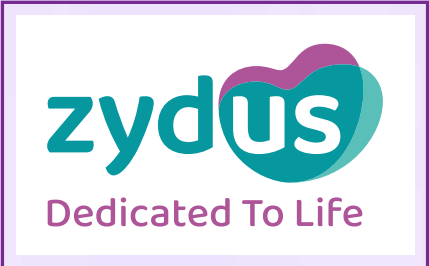
